

1. Where is the Link to my Fundraising Page?

The family member who registered your family to serve with Lighthouse is most likely the designated 'fundraiser'. Here's how to find the link to their fundraising page:

- The family member who registered your family should <u>log in to their GoMethod account</u> and locate the link listed on their dashboard under "Your trip page". This is your fundraising page.
- This is the link you can send via email or share on your social media for others to donate towards your retreat.
- If more than one member of your family/group needs their own fundraising page, please let us know.

2. How Do We Customize Our Fundraising Page?

We encourage you to add a personal message on your fundraising page, here are a few things to think through when deciding what to say-

Prepare your story- What motivates you to serve with Lighthouse? Answer this and you are ready to invite others to partner with you.

Share the impact- Include a few of the many ways you will be strengthening families on retreat such as:

 Providing time on retreat each day for parents to connect with other parents going through this difficult journey (We call it Common Ground)


Providing time each day for children on treatment and their siblings to have fun and just be kids with

other kids their age (We call it Flip Flop)

How to add your story:

- The family member who has the fundraising page should log into GoMethod
- Click on the 'Trip Story' button on the left side menu
- Add your message and click the 'Save Story' button

Log in to my GoMethod account






3. How Do We Pay the non-refundable \$250 Deposit for Our Family?

Each volunteer family is responsible for a nonrefundable \$250 deposit which is due within two weeks of acceptance onto retreat.

The full balance of this deposit does contribute to your family's overall fundraising and secures your spot on retreat.

To pay your family's deposit, please make a gift of \$250 to your family's fundraising page. You can pay using credit card or ACH debit from a bank account.

 If you prefer to pay your deposit by check, please make it out to 'Lighthouse Family Retreat' and mail it to: <u>Lighthouse Family Retreat, Inc., P.O. Box</u> <u>117823, Atlanta, GA 30303-3456.</u> Please include your retreat number, family name, and 'deposit' on the memo line.

4. How Much is Our Family Supposed to Raise?

The following describes the minimums required to attend and goals we ask you to aim for:

FUNDRAISING MINIMUMS:

These are the minimum amounts that must be raised or personally provided in order to attend the retreat:

- \$1700 per adult (18 and older)
- \$500 per child (17 and younger)


On average, the minimums raised leave a \$20,000 gap in the cost of each retreat. We know everyone's fundraising capacity is different. Therefore, if you are able, we invite you to help us bridge this gap by setting a goal above your minimum. This helps make it possible for us to continue serving all families living through childhood cancer on retreat at no cost to them. (Suggested amount - \$500 - \$1,000 or more above your minimum to help us bridge the gap).





5. Where Can I See How Much I've Raised So Far?

- The family member who is assigned as 'fundraiser' should log in to their GoMethod account and view their dashboard.
- To view the details of your funding click 'Funding' on the left side menu. This will display gift amounts and donors.





6. Can We Accept Donations Made by Check?

Yes! Checks are certainly an option for donations towards your retreat. Here's how it works:

- Make sure the check is made out to 'Lighthouse Family Retreat'.
- Please include your retreat number and family name on the memo line.
- Either you or your donors should mail it to our regular donation address:

7. Fundraising Ideas



Plan an event

- Invite a small group of friends and family over to share with them about the retreat you'll be serving on, tell them you are raising support and you'd love for them to partner with you.
- Have a backyard chili or BBQ cookoff.
- Host a neighborhood yard sale and have proceeds go to Lighthouse. People may be willing to pay more knowing it's going to a great cause!
- Host a small kickball, softball, football tournament... you name it! Have everyone pay an entry fee to play and everyone can compete while having some fun.
- Host an ice cream party or pancake breakfast. While everyone is enjoying the sweet treat, your family can share about your plans to serve with Lighthouse. If possible, have a slideshow with pictures ready to share during the meeting. We can provide a slideshow for you to use if you've never been on retreat before or you can make your own! If you're not able to meet in person, try hosting a virtual party!
- Host a neighborhood bake sale or car wash





7. Fundraising Ideas Continued

Bingo challenge board

- Who doesn't love a good challenge? We have created a fun way for you and your family to bond while engaging your network. Everyone can play along at their own comfort level!
- Print out the bingo challenge board or share on your social media pages. (Download here: https://bit.ly/33BhQ3g)
- Choose a dollar amount for the blank boxes on the board that you feel comfortable asking your network to donate.
- Participate in the challenges yourself and be sure to post pictures/videos.
- Tag a few friends and family to do a specific activity on the board.
- Come up with some goals for your family through the Bingo Challenge Board and let your network know!

• Reach 10 new people each week

• Set a calendar reminder to reach out to 10 new people each week. Set up meetings, video meetings, or a phone calls to share personally about why you want to serve with Lighthouse.

Service Projects

- Do you have older kids who want to get involved? Have them send out flyers to neighbors letting them
 know about various skills they can put into practice such as mowing lawns, gardening, dog walking etc.
- Include a suggested donation amount and leave the rest up to them!



7. Fundraising Ideas Continued



Matching Gifts

- Ask your company if they match for nonprofit donations and have your friends/family who work for their companies do the same. They will double the money given to you quickly!
- Have a friend or family member who is a generous giver? Ask them to match the donations you collect up to a
 certain amount. People love to donate when their dollars are being matched.
- Planning to pay your own way to Lighthouse? Ask your friends for prayer support and let them know you'll
 match their donation!

Give something up to get something better

- What better way to celebrate your birthday than by giving to others? Use your personalized fundraising page and instead of gifts, ask friends and family to donate to your trip.
- Is there something you regularly treat yourself to like coffee, breakfast, or energy drinks? Plan to give these up until your retreat...use the money that you'd spend on these and put it toward your retreat.

Ask others for ideas

- Lighthouse is blessed with incredible volunteers. Many of them return year after year and have a lot of great
 experience raising support. Ask your teammates what has worked for them over the years. They'd love to be a
 resource for you!
- Don't forget about Google...new ideas are being shared all the time.

8. Holiday Specific Fundraising Ideas

- New Years Themed Fundraising Ideas-
 - Offer to build charcuterie boards for friends and families New Years celebration events.
 - Host a "fireworks show" for your friends and family and take donations as tickets
- Valentines Day Themed Fundraising Ideas-
 - Partner with a local flower shop or candy store to support your retreat by donating a portion of their profit through the Valentines season.
 - Create an auction of Valentines themed gift baskets/gifts
- Easter Themed Fundraising Ideas-
 - Organize a community Easter Egg hunt and take donations as tickets to join the fun!
 - Host an Easter breakfast and take donations as tickets to the meal
- Fourth of July Themed Fundraising Ideas-
 - Host a community BBQ event and take donations as tickets
 - Put together a lemonade stand for your neighborhood

Thanksgiving Themed Fundraising Ideas-



- Fall themed bake sale
- Host a chili cook off
- Pumpkin carving contest
- Host a football tournament
- Host a backyard movie night- Invite family and friends to "purchase a ticket" through a donation to your fundraising efforts
- Christmas Themed Fundraising Ideas-



- Cookie decorating
- Christmas themed bake sale
- Host a Christmas themed movie night
- Offer to help decorate neighbors homes for Christmas
- Offer to help wrap gifts for your friends and family
- Offer to babysit for friends and family
- End of Year-



- Invite your family and friends to consider supporting your retreat experience through an end of the year gift
- Offer to build charcuterie boards for friends and families
 New Years celebration events





9. Sample Fundraising Letter



A personal letter inviting your friends and family to support your retreat can go a long way!

- 1. Pray through who you would like to send a letter to inviting them to support your Lighthouse retreat.
- 2. Personalize the letter for your family.
- 3. Send the letter out to your community!

10. Can I make an Instagram/Facebook fundraiser for my retreat?

There is a processing fee associated with using Instagram and Facebook fundraisers, this amount will be deducted from the amount that is credited to your account for fundraising.

If you would like to avoid this fee you can simply post your LFR fundraising link to your posts. See images for example.

We recommend sharing your personal trip fundraising link from GoMethod directly to your Facebook or Instagram page. This means all the donations will immediately reflect on your fundraising page.







11. Can We Raise More Than Our Family Minimums?



Absolutely! Once you have reached your minimums, we encourage you to continue fundraising.

All funds raised in excess of your goal will be put towards retreats to help cover the cost of retreat families and other expenses related to retreats. You can also continue raising funds after your trip is over.



12. What If I Am Falling Short Of My Fundraising Minimum?

If you are concerned that your fundraising efforts may come up short for your family requirements, we suggest the following:

- 1. Make it a matter of prayer. Ask the Lord for wisdom and provision.
- 2. Contact your Family Partner Lead and ask them for advice. Tell them what you've done and ask for additional ideas to help.
- 3. Self-fund. Some volunteers self-fund in order to reach their minimum. It's a great investment in your family and others.




13. How do I see who has donated to my retreat?
